DFW Connector: Work Zone Safety Scholarship

Purpose:

Owned by the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), the DFW Connector project will reconstruct 8.4 miles of state highways 114 and 121 north of the DFW Airport. NorthGate Constructors is working in collaboration with TxDOT to develop, design and reconstruct \$1.02 billion worth of improvements in Grapevine and Southlake, Texas as part of the DFW Connector project.

The DFW Connector project is committed to promoting safe driving practices on our roads, and in particular in our work zone, for the safety of drivers and our workers. The NorthGate Constructors Public Information team has created banners, bumper magnets and a dedicated work zone safety page on the DFW Connector project website (www.DFWConnector.com) to promote work zone safety.

The next step in our work zone safety campaign is to involve the local communities closest to the project (Grapevine and Southlake) in the work zone safety campaign. Through these work zone safety scholarships, NorthGate Constructors hopes that scholarship recipients' entries will inspire drivers to:

1. Drive the posted speed limit of 50 mph through the work zone.
2. Limit cell phone usage while driving in the work zone.

Amount/number of scholarships:

NorthGate Constructors will grant two \$5,000 scholarships – one scholarship to a student (freshman through senior) at each GCISD high school.

Scholarship requirements:

- Scholarship entry must focus specifically on the importance of driving safely, especially in a work zone.
- Applicant must be a full-time high school student (freshman through senior) at Grapevine High or Colleyville Heritage High.
- Applicant must graduate from one of these two high schools and continue their education following high school in order to receive the scholarship money.
- The DFW Connector project reserves the right to post (on the project website, in e-mail alerts etc.), print or use all entries to promote work zone safety awareness and involvement.
- Scholarship entry should encourage people to take our DFW Connector Work Zone Safety pledge, although this is not required. Please see www.DFWConnector.com/workzonesafety.php for more information.

Scholarship distribution:

The Education Foundation will be provided with the scholarship check. The Education Foundation will pass on this money to the school that the scholarship recipient attends. If the student recipient chooses to not continue his or her education following high school, the scholarship money will be given to the Education Foundation to use as it chooses.

Part IV. Work zone safety scholarship entry (85 pts.)

NorthGate Constructors will accept entries in a variety of formats (listed below), but all entries should focus specifically on the importance of driving safely, especially in a work zone. Electronic submissions should be submitted on a CD, and all other submissions should be originals or printed.

1. ____ Electronic submission: Video (one to two minutes in length, wmv format)
2. ____ Electronic submission: Microsoft PowerPoint presentation (maximum 15 slides, must include both text and pictures)
3. ____ Electronic submission: Banner design (must provide in high-quality PDF format)
4. ____ Original or printed submission: Informative or persuasive essay (maximum three pages, 12 pt. font, 1.5 lines spacing)
5. ____ Original or printed submission: Photos (maximum ten photos)
6. ____ Original or printed submission: Drawing/painting

The DFW Connector project scholarship evaluation committee will also use the short answer questions below in their decision to choose scholarship winners. Please respond to Part V on your own paper (five to ten sentences each question). Please retype each question before typing your answer to assist the review committee.

1. Why is speeding or texting/talking on a cell phone in a work zone more dangerous than at any other time?
2. In your opinion, what is the best way to convince people to slow down and limit their cell phone use when driving in a work zone?
3. Defend or reject the following statement: "I'm a safe driver. I only speed 5 to 10 mph over the speed limit, and I only text at red lights."
